Introduction

Thank you for purchasing *Bookworm Sort Fiction and Nonfiction Sheets and Centers*. I hope it helps the children you work with learn about fiction and nonfiction books.

This product comes with two worksheets, two centers, and answer keys. One worksheet is a cut and paste activity and the other requires children to label book titles as **fiction** or **nonfiction**. The centers require children to sort book titles by category.

Instructions for Making the Bookworm Sort Centers:

Print the Bookworm Sort pages on paper or cardstock. You'll need two copies of each if you want to have both centers available at the same time. Laminate for durability if desired. Print the Books on cardstock and cut out. Laminate for durability if desired. Print the labels, answer keys, and directions on paper or card stock and cut out. Glue the labels onto business sized envelopes. If you like, you can laminate the answer keys and directions for durability.

To make the Centers, put the book cards and directions into an envelope. Glue or tape the label to the outside of the envelope.

Answer keys can be stored in a separate envelope.

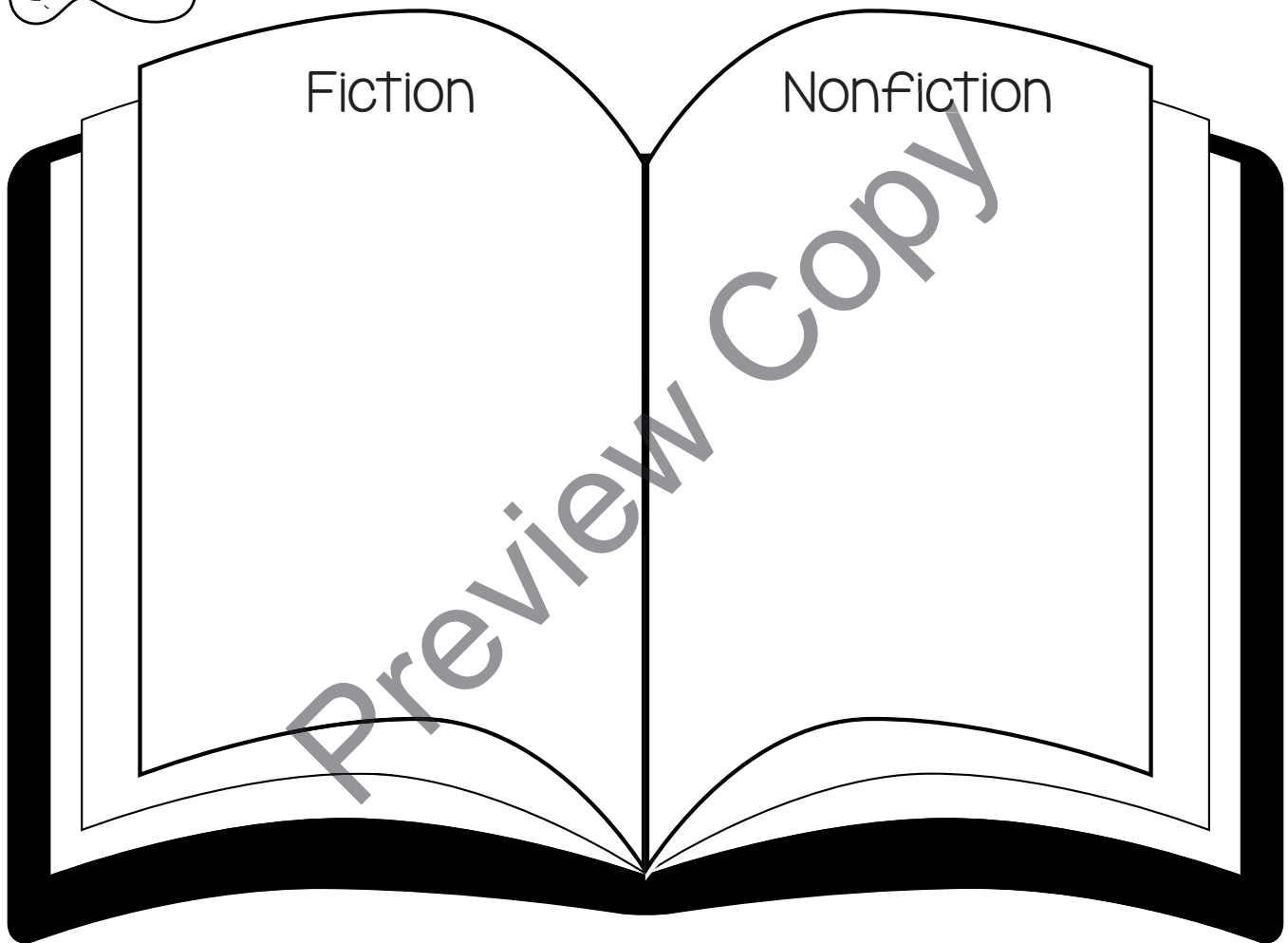
